### **This week's health care reform news:**

#### **Change to out-of-pocket cap to proceed**

The Obama administration announced it will proceed with a planned change to out-of-pocket cap calculations. The out-of-pocket cost for individuals enrolled in family plans would be capped at the individual limit of \$6,850 per year, instead of the family limit.

#### **Other highlights include:**

- **Arkansas** issues guidance on standards for health plan renewal and discontinuance notifications.
- **Nevada** Health Insurance Exchange Board exploring possibility of seeking a State Innovation Grant to support growth and expansion of the exchange.
- **North Carolina** legislators expected to consider a Medicaid reform plan next week.

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
