This week's health care reform news:

Congress considering less dramatic changes to ACA

The U.S. House of Representatives and the Senate have passed a bill that would allow states to treat businesses with 51-100 employees as large employers while retaining the option to classify these groups as small employers.

Other highlights include:

- **Michigan's** Department of Health and Human Services received \$70 million in federal funding to support innovative health care system enhancements.
- **Washington** state's Health Benefit Exchange enrollees must pay their insurance companies directly.
- A Medicaid expansion plan drafted by **Utah** leaders would hit various health care industry players with \$50 million in new fees and cost increases.

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
