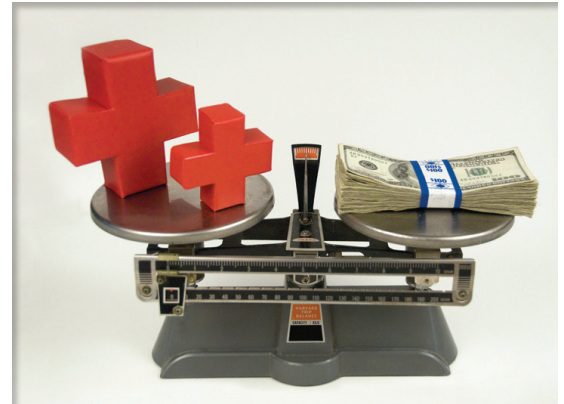

How Does HealthPak Work?

How To Use HealthPak.

To be eligible for TransConnect benefits, the employee must be covered by a qualified major medical plan. Employees receive an identification card to present at the time of service that allows their providers to be paid directly after the major medical carrier determines the employee's financial responsibility for the claim. To access critical illness and accident benefits, the employee completes a claim form and benefits are paid directly to the employee.

MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN

\$3,000 deductible | 80/20 co-insurance | \$6,000 out-of-pocket maximum
TransConnect benefit is \$6,000 inpatient/\$3,000 outpatient.
