Health insurance premiums increased modestly, out-of-pocket costs swiftly in 2015

New Kaiser Family Foundation research found that single and family premiums for employer-sponsored health insurance in 2015 rose by an average of 4 percent, while deductibles rose 67 percent since 2010.

- **New York's** state Department of Financial Services will close down the Health Republic co-op effective year-end.
