U.S. Senate introduces bipartisan mental health legislation

Bipartisan mental health legislation was introduced in the U.S. Senate last week, a response in part to mass shootings in the past couple of years.

Other highlights include:

- The Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) in **Illinois** to continue making payments to all providers who treat children during the state's budget impasse.
- **New Hampshire's** Executive Council approves a \$1.6 billion contract extension for two managed care companies administering the state's Medicare program.
- **Tennessee's** Department of Insurance issues memorandum requiring PBMs to update reference prices and reimbursement amounts.
